Commanding the Mayday

1. Clear radio traffic, "Emergency traffic only" and attempt to confirm the Mayday.
2. Ascertain LUNAR facts if possible-
 - a. Location
 - b. Unit
 - c. Name
 - d. Air level
 - e. Resources needed
3. Have Firefighter activate PASS device
4. Have crews working in last known area assist trapped firefighter if possible
5. Request RIC Team Leader and Safety Officer (or other Officer that will be the Rescue group supervisor) to the Command post
 - a. Deploy RIC
 - i. Assign Safety Officer/Chief Officer as Rescue Group Supervisor
6. Announce Fireground Strategy
7. If Mayday is broadcast on the active tactical channel, move all other operations to another TAC channel, If the EMER button was pushed the rescue operations will utilize the Emergency channel for their operations. The Rescue operations should remain on the broadcasted Mayday channel.
8. Request additional resources
9. Assign additional resources to the Rescue Group
 - a. Collapse requires tech members
10. Perform a roll call
 - a. How do we ask for one?
 - b. How do divisions report?
11. Create a Medical group
12. Continue to Command existing operations
13. Announce "Mayday is all clear"

Should RIC fall under IC or Safety Officer on the IC chart and who do they report to?

What does dispatch do on a MAYDAY?

Consideration should be given to assigning technical specialties as RIC on specific known hazard buildings (i.e. Safeway plant)

**IC can call for a roll call at any time during an incident

MAYDAY COMMAND CHECKLIST

- Acknowledge MAYDAY, announce "Emergency Traffic Only"
Emergency Traffic Only, unit calling Mayday identify

- Ascertain LUNAAR Facts _____
Repeat facts back to Mayday: E-5 Firefighter Jones is out of air on the second floor, east end of the hallway, you are not trapped.

- Inform MAYDAY Firefighter to activate PASS
Firefighter Jones, remain calm and activate your PASS. We have crews on the way.

- Implement Rescue Plan with Supervisor:
 - a) Existing DIV Supervisor with RIC added
 - b) Safety as Rescue Group with RIC added
 - c) RIC w/ Officer become Rescue Group*Announce: XXX Command reporting a Mayday on Floor 2. Emergency Traffic Only. E-5 Firefighter Jones is out of air on the second floor, east end of the hallway. He is not trapped.*

E-5 from XXX Command. FF Jones is separated from your crew, do you know his last location and are you nearby to assist him?

Safety from XXX Command....you are activated as the Rescue Group Supervisor with E-2 assigned as RIC. Respond to the Mayday on floor 2 to locate Firefighter Jones. He is out of air and last reported at the east end of the hallway. The Rescue Group Supervisor will handle all communications with the Mayday Firefighter.

- Confirm and announce Fireground Strategy
 - a) Direct personnel away from collapse area
 - b) Direct personnel to support rescue operation*All units from XXX Command, Maintain your current fireground assignments. A Rescue Group is responding to the Mayday.*

- Move Fireground Operations to another TAC _____
All fireground units not assigned to the Mayday switch to Tac 4, Switch to Tac 4. Tac 4 is clear of radio traffic restrictions. Resume normal radio traffic.

- Maintain Fireground operations using SA or staff

- Suggested SA Activity

PREPARE FOR R.I.T. EARLY

(4TH ENGINE ADDED TO CONFIRMED FIRE RESPONSE)

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LAST DRILL "COMMANDING THE MAYDAY"

ESTABLISH A R.I.T. GROUP SUPERVISOR.

GIVE OBJECTIVES AND ASSIGN THEM THE 4TH DUE ENGINE CO.

WHO TO USE; ISO, ADDITIONAL BC, TRAINING DIVISION STAFF.

(Refrain from using and stripping the C/O from RIT Engine)
